



As the following financial report shows, 2019 was a tremendous year for the Delaware Lottery. Over the past year, we contributed \$213.8 million to the State General Fund which helps to provide valuable services to everyone that lives, works and plays in Delaware.

These financial results were made possible by the hard work and dedication of the Delaware Lottery team. It takes a dedicated team to continuously and successfully deliver on our mission.

Traditional sales from the Instant Scratch and Draw products reached a record for the twelve months ending June 30, 2019. With net sales up 11 percent from fiscal year 2018, we were able to beat our revenue projections.

With the expansion of Sports Lottery to include all sports for the entire fiscal year, sales increased dramatically — \$103.9 million for fiscal year 2019 over fiscal year 2018.

From full-scale sports wagering and the largest jackpot in MEGA MILLIONS® history, to introducing Collect 'N Win and a Licensed Partner Instant Game that provided the chance for a Delaware Lottery player to win up to \$1 billion, 2019 continued a trend of positive growth among our offerings.

Our mission has always been to maximize revenue for the State General Fund, and all of us at the Delaware Lottery would like to thank our retailers, players and vendors for making this year so successful.

Since the start of operations in 1975, the Delaware Lottery has contributed over \$5.4 billion to the State General Fund. I look forward to continuing our winning tradition in 2020.

Draw Games

After 15 great years, HOT LOTTO® was officially retired after its final drawing on Saturday, Oct. 28, 2018. The Delaware Lottery is pleased to recognize 33 big Delaware winners in the game's lifetime. Of the big winners, 14 claimed a \$10,000 prize, 14 claimed a \$30,000 prize, four players were HOT LOTTO® Sizzler winners and one player won a \$16.69 million jackpot.

America's newest multi-state lottery multimillion-dollar draw game, LOTTO AMERICA® with All-Star Bonus, was introduced on Wednesday, November 15, 2018. LOTTO AMERICA® is \$1 to play and has a starting grand prize of \$2 million.



Instant Games

Offering licensed products along with our standard instant scratch games helps us to attract a variety of players. The highlight this year included a new Licensed Property Instant Ticket with Second Chance Promotion from Scientific Games - WILLY WONKA GOLDEN TICKET™. The game included a Second Chance Drawing, where one lucky Delaware player won a trip to Las Vegas and a chance at up to \$1 billion. The BILLION DOLLAR CHALLENGE™ was held on April 16, 2019, and the trip included a 4-day/3-night trip for two; round-trip airfare; hotel accommodations (double occupancy); ground transportation at destination; \$1,000 spending money; admission to the BILLION DOLLAR CHALLENGE™ theater/venue for the Prizewinner and a guest with a chance for the Prizewinner to participate in the BILLION DOLLAR CHALLENGE™ event along with a group of Lottery winners from across the United States.



Sponsorships

The Delaware Lottery continued their long-standing sponsorships with University of Delaware, Delaware State University and Wilmington Blue Rocks, participating in a variety of cooperative sports programs conducted during the spring, fall and winter sports seasons. In addition, the Lottery continued relationships with the Delaware State Fair as their Summer Concert Series sponsor, as well as with other local events like the Out and About Loop Series, Wyoming Peach Festival, Milford Bud & Bug Festival, Saint Anthony's Italian Festival, Dover Days and The Lady Bug Festival.







MEGA MILLIONS®

In October of 2018, MEGA MILLIONS® reached its highest jackpot of all time at \$1.5 billion. This jackpot was the second-largest lottery jackpot of all time and contributed to a noticeable rise in sales both throughout Delaware and across the country.

Collect 'N Win

On March 1, 2019, the Delaware Lottery launched Collect 'N Win, a loyalty-based rewards program where players age 18 years and older can earn entries to win monthly cash prizes by submitting eligible, non-winning Delaware Lottery Draw and Instant Game tickets. Players collect symbols for their Delaware Lottery Collect 'N Win play card based on the non-winning ticket submissions. Once all six symbols on a play card are collected, the player will automatically be entered to win monthly cash prizes. iPhone users can download the Collect 'N Win app directly from the Apple store and Android users can download the app directly from delottery.com. Since the launch, over 12,000 players have registered for Collect 'N Win.

Retail

Nearly 600 Delaware Lottery retailers can be found throughout the State of Delaware. We work to make our products accessible and convenient for our players. Most of our players can count on finding the products they love in the stores they regularly visit. We support our retailers by providing merchandising solutions, promotional offerings, training and regular visits from the Delaware Lottery Sales Representatives.

Clearly, Delaware Lottery retailers help us help Delaware. During FY 2019, we added 13 retailers to our network. In return, the Delaware Lottery paid more than \$12,178,982 in traditional Lottery commissions and \$220,505,633 in total commissions to our retailers this past year, not to mention generating foot traffic in their stores and the add-on sales resulting from that traffic. It truly is a winning partnership.







Delaware Racetracks and Casinos

Delaware's racetracks and casinos offer more than 6,200 of the very best Video Lottery machines in the country; Live Table Games including Blackjack, Roulette, Craps and Poker; and Internet Gaming available through each casino website.

Video Lottery and Table Games

Video Lottery and Table Games revenue increased 3.8% and 3.6%, respectively, for fiscal year 2019 over fiscal year 2018, following industry-wide trends. Table Games net revenue totaled more than \$56 million and Video Lottery net proceeds totaled more than \$367 million.

The Delaware Lottery has extended its contract with Gaming Labs International (GLI) to provide video lottery testing, inspection and consulting services for one year. Existing contracts for vendors who provide Video Lottery Terminals (VLTs) were extended for two years.

There are 497 charitable VLTs operating in 48 approved charitable gaming organizations. In fiscal year 2019, there were ten winners of VLT jackpots over \$50,000; two of them were over \$100,000.

iGaming

On October 25, 2018, the Android app was launched to all iGaming players. However, it was a Dover Downs player utilizing the iOS mobile app that won the highest jackpot since launch. On Christmas Day, the player collected \$213,969.83 from Santa's Super Slot.

Fiscal year 2019 ended with a 45.20% increase in net revenue (\$3,171,842.80) compared to FY 2018 (\$2,184,534.74).
